## **INSTRUCTOR PROFILES**



**Tim Collings**

Tim Collings was the Senior Building Inspector for Salt Lake City Corporation specializing in Plumbing, Mechanical and Fire Protection systems for 37 years. ### **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS**

**CISPI Cast Iron/Plumbing training.** This will a 4-hour presentation on the following ICC CEU approved presentations and will sponsor lunch for attendees at the UAPMO conference. Benefits of Cast Iron, Fire Resistivity Benefits of Cast Iron, Underground Installations, Cast Iron the Logical Choice, Sustainability. (James A. Walls)

**Hands on Ducting class based on Manual D and gas sizing** (By Jason Van Ausdal) This class provides an understanding of Manual D by using a mock air handler and several scenarios of ducting installation and its effect on the equipment. We will discuss key things to watch for with installations and why it is important to follow through. The second half of the class will be based on the Fuel gas code and gas piping sizing and installation. Come prepared to be challenged and design systems.

**IRC, IPC, IMC, and IFGC update with state amendments.** (By Tim Collings) This will be a seminar-type class that will cover IRC/IPC venting methodology, drainage, domestic water backflow protection, and anti-scald devices requirements and installation. We will also discuss Utah State amendment to the IRC, IPC, and IMC. Mechanical and fuel gas update will include direct vent appliance requirements, Gas pipe hybrid sizing, branch, and longest length methods will be discussed.
