This course simplifies the structural provisions of the International Residential Code (IRC), focusing on key topics like design criteria, load paths, foundations, walls, floors, decks, and roofs. It also addresses common structural mistakes and highlights Utah-specific amendments for plan reviews and inspections. The course is taught by Chris Kimball, co-founder of Building Code Solutions (BCS), and a licensed civil, structural, and fire protection engineer. He is an ICC Master Code Professional and approved ICC instructor who regularly trains building officials, design professionals, and contractor organizations.
